# **GPRA Federal Reporting Requirements**

#### The GPRA Client Outcome Measure Tool is:

- » A 30-minute survey
- » For clients receiving SOR-funded treatment or services
- » A structured interview
- » Administered at intake, follow-up, and discharge

**SOR-funded organizations are only required to administer the GPRA Tool at intake**. The Behavioral Health Administration has partnered with The Evaluation Center at the University of Colorado Denver to collect and report GPRA data for the six-month follow-up and discharge requirements.

The GPRA Tool (Survey) was developed using existing data collection instruments, including the Addiction Severity Index. Measures collected in the tool include the following:

- Demographics
- Substance Use
- Planned Services
- Living Conditions
- Education
- Employment and Income
- Legal Status
- Mental and Physical Health Problems, Treatment, and Recovery
- Social Connectedness

SOR-funded organizations are encouraged to use client responses to the GPRA Intake Survey to fulfill their internal intake requirements, if applicable. All GPRA Intake Survey questions must be asked as stated in the tool
